# **UNIFORM POLICY FOR NAVARRE MS**

Students are expected to dress appropriately for school. The responsibility for student dress is that of the student and the parent. The following guidelines should be followed:

## **School Uniform Policy**

### SHIRTS

- 1. Polo/Oxford long/short sleeve
- 2. A navy, black or white collared shirt must be worn at all times.
- 3. Undershirts must be white with no writing or pictures.
- Sweaters/Vests/Crewnecks
  - 1. Navy, black or white
  - 2. NO coats, outerwear, or hooded sweatshirts may be worn at any time in the building.
  - 3. Zip up or pullover jackets and sweaters must be solid color, navy, black, or white, no designs, lettering, etc. Any insignia other than Navarre no larger than 2 inches.

### PANTS/SKIRTS/DRESSES/SHORTS

- 1. Pants/Skirts/Dresses/Shorts must be navy, black, or tan/khaki No denim materials
- 2. No leggings/yoga pants/jeggings
- 3. Shorts must be at modest lengths. NO shorter than between fingertips and the knee. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 4. Skirts and Dresses must be at modest lengths. NO shorter than between fingertips and the knee. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 5. Solid navy, black, or tan/khaki leggings may be worn under skirts.

#### FOOTWEAR

- 1. Heels and toes must be fully covered
- 2. No flip flops, house shoes, slippers
- 3. Shoelaces must be tied
- 4. Shoes must have a sole

#### ACCESSORIES

- 1. Belts: No obscene words or graphics
- 2. No large emblems Neckwear may be worn with oxford shirts
- 3. Jewelry must be modest; no costume jewelry
- 4. Hats, scarves, gloves should be removed upon entering the building.
- 5. No bandanas, wave setter caps, sweat bands, or hair nets are to be worn inside the building or at school functions.

### Dress Down Policy (No Uniform Days-NUT)

Students may not wear, or be in possession of the following items during dress down days:

- 1. Head or face coverings
- 2. Articles that reveal the back, chest, upper-thigh, or undergarments. Shirts must cover the stomach.
- 3. Shorts that are shorter than mid-thigh in length (fingertip rule)
- 4. Ripped pants, unless tights or leggings are worn underneath
- 5. Tank tops with straps thinner than two-fingers width

- 6. Pants/shorts that hang below the waist (students who are wearing saggy pants will be asked to wear a belt)
- 7. Articles that contain offensive writing, graphics, pictures, or gang symbols.
- 8. Articles that depict logos or emblems of drugs, tobacco, or alcohol.
- 9. Pajamas, slippers, nightgowns
- 10. Any revealing, offensive or other items deemed inappropriate by the administrator.

# FRIDAYS ARE SPIRIT DAYS

Students may wear Navarre T-Shirt or Navarre gear on Fridays with <u>uniform pants, skirts or</u> <u>shorts.</u>
